

Reminder About HIPAA Privacy Notice

The Privacy Rule under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 ("HIPAA") governs how the BAC International Health Fund may use and disclose protected health information and the rights of individuals that are covered under the plan. We provided you with a copy of this notice in 2003.

The Privacy Rule also requires that we provide you with a reminder about the availability of this Notice or how to obtain a copy of the Notice at least once every three years.
